Events and Recurrence Masters

- Event = one-off activity
- Recurrence Master is for events that occur on a schedule, e.g. weekly, bi-monthly
- You can change dates/times of individual occurrences of a recurring event
- If you add instances to a time period that already has instances, they will be replaced


- Defaults to your county
- Need to select the appropriate group within the county:

This ensures the hours are reported correctly


Cleaning up User Profile

- One volunteer group per member
 - Shows alignment
 - Does not prevent searching for events elsewhere in the state
- Remember to update level
 - **New Volunteers** = recently registered
 - **Level One** = new amateurs needing to complete training, or volunteers who participated on a limited basis
 - **Level Two** = Received core training (ICS 100, 200, 700, 800), experienced operators: ready to deploy
 - The volunteer records the training they've completed
 - The EC verifies the completion and updates the level
 - Level Three = leaders: SEC, DECs, ECs, and their assistants
- Please review your roster
 - Remove volunteers from your group if they are not in your roster
 - Add any missing members to your group
